

ACCREDITED NAPIT CERTIFICATION SCHEME FOR OPERATIVES UNDERTAKING ELECTRICAL WORK

As from 4th January 2016 Blue Flame Certification ceased to offer UKAS accredited assessments for electrical operatives including:

- FS 1** Installation, Inspection, Testing, Verification & Certification of Installations to BS 7671: 2008 (Requirements for Electrical Installations) for Electrical Operatives
- JS 1** Installation, Inspection, Testing, Verification & Certification of Installations to BS 7671: 2008 (Requirements for Electrical Installations) for Electrical Operatives (Jersey)
- DS 1** Installation, Inspection, Testing & Certification of Installations to BS 7671: 2008 (Requirements for Electrical Installations) for Defined Scope Electrical Operatives
- DS 2** Installation, Inspection, Testing & Certification of Installations to BS 7671: 2008 (Requirements for Electrical Installations) for Defined Scope Electrical Operatives including the additional requirements related to Electrical Installations Associated with the Heating Industry (*Non Electric Heating Systems*)
- DS 3** Installation, Inspection, Testing & Certification of Installations to BS 7671: 2008 (Requirements for Electrical Installations) for Defined Scope Electrical Operatives including the additional requirements related to Multiple Circuit Electrical Installations (*Power, Lighting & Protective Bonding*)

All certificates issued against the above categories will remain valid up to the date of expiry on the Certificate(s) and will be supported technically by the Scheme Owner NAPIT Certification Ltd.

Valid Certificates will enable holders to be able to register with Competent Persons Schemes recognised by the Department of Communities and Local Government (DCLG) for Electrotechnical Technologies that the respective Scheme is approved for and as detailed on the Certificate(s).
